

KILLINGHALL COMMUNITY DEFIBRILLATOR



The yellow AED (Automated External Defibrillator) is installed outside the Otley Road entrance to the Village Hall (LHS when facing the Hall from the street) and is registered with the Yorkshire Ambulance Service.

Procedure to follow in the case of emergency:-

- Dial 999 and ask for **AMBULANCE**
- If the AED is required the Call taker will tell you where the nearest cabinet is within a 600m radius
- You will be told the code which is used to unlock the cabinet try to note it down if possible.
- Once back with the patient lift the lid of the device then listen and follow the instructions it gives you
- Once the pads are placed on the patient the AED will decide whether a shock is required
It will not advise OR deliver a shock if the patient's heart isn't in a shockable rhythm
- Keep following the AED's instructions until the Ambulance Service arrive and take over
- If possible the AED should be returned to the cabinet after use
